

# Access to Federal Health Care Services Region VIII

## Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA)

*The primary Federal agency for improving access to health care services for people who are uninsured, isolated, or medically vulnerable*

### Find a Health Center:

HRSA-sponsored health centers provide comprehensive primary and preventive health care and supportive services to medically underserved communities and vulnerable populations. Services are provided to all patients, regardless of insurance status or ability to pay.

### Find Ryan White HIV/AIDS Medical Care Providers:

The Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program provides HIV-related primary medical care and essential support services for those who do not have sufficient health care coverage or financial resources for coping with HIV disease. The program fills gaps in care not met by other payers.

### Find Critical Access Hospitals:

Critical Access Hospitals (CAH) provide outpatient and inpatient hospital services in rural areas, and are certified to receive cost-based reimbursement from Medicare. CAHs maintain no more than 25 beds, have an average length-of-stay of 96 hours or less, and provide 24-hour emergency services.

### Find Rural Health Clinics:

Rural Health Clinics (RHC) are required to provide outpatient primary care services and basic laboratory services, and are certified to receive special Medicare and Medicaid reimbursement. RHCs are located in rural, underserved areas and are staffed at least 50 percent of the time with a midlevel practitioner.

*The Federal Health Program for American Indians and Alaska Natives*

### **Find Health Care:**

Includes IHS, Tribal, and Urban Indian Health programs. IHS facilities include hospitals, health locations, health centers, school health centers, health stations, dental clinics, alcohol substance abuse treatment facilities, and behavioral health facilities.
