Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA)

The Federal agency that works to improve the quality and availability of substance abuse prevention, alcohol and drug addiction treatment, and mental health services

Indian Health Service (IHS)

The Federal Health Program for American Indians and Alaska Natives

Veterans Health Administration (VA)

The largest integrated health care system in the U.S. with over 1,700 sites of care, serving 8.76 million veterans each year

Comprehensive primary health care services provided to medically underserved communities & vulnerable populations, regardless of ability to pay

Find Ryan White HIV/AIDS Medical Care Providers:

HIV-related primary medical care and support services provided for those without sufficient health care coverage or financial resources

Find Critical Access Hospitals:

Rural outpatient/inpatient hospital services provided; certified to receive cost-based Medicare reimbursement; ≤ 25 beds; average length-of-stay ≤ 96 hours; 24-hour emergency services

Find Rural Health Clinics:

Outpatient primary care services provided; certified to receive special Medicare and Medicaid reimbursement; staff includes one or more midlevel practitioners
